Following are descriptions of selected areas where we can use your help in the future, and how you may fit in. All positions require the ability to work hard while having a great experience.

## **Parking Lot Chaperones:**

You will be needed to meet and greet a specific band and you will be their chaperone from the time they step off the bus until they have performed. Personality and attention to detail are key factors here.

## **Pit Area Crew:**

You will be needed to help each band carry and place pit equipment unto the field before their performance and at the conclusion. Instrument weights vary, so make sure you’re stretching beforehand.

## **Grandstand Security:**

This requires making sure that spectators are seated as each performance begins until it is completed, assisting spectators to make sure they are in the correct seats, and making sure no one is in the step-walkway areas during a performance.

## **‘Cavalcade Gives Back’:**

The CBA canned food drive was a great success this past year and will be an ongoing project. We need people to supervise this area. Collecting food and totaling the poundage are the biggest requirements here.

In return for your help at these Championship events, you will receive passes to get into any CBA-sponsored shows through the year and the use of our Hospitality Room for food and warmth through the weekend.
